Ofsted inspection As you know, our school was inspected last week by Tracey Ralph, HMI. This was an ungraded inspection over two days to check whether our school continues to be good, five and a half years since we were last inspected. The outcome of the inspection remains confidential until the report has been quality assured, but I would like to thank the parents and children who responded to the inspector, either online or in person. I am also very grateful to the committed and hard-working staff members and governors, who dedicated so much time and effort to preparing for and responding to the process.

Strike Action by NEU teachers I wrote to parents yesterday to inform you about the forthcoming strike action on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July. This action relates not just to pay and conditions for teachers, but to the approach to funding of education in England which continues to erode school budgets, reducing capacity to meet the needs of pupils. Union members are not obliged to indicate whether or not they intend to strike ahead of time, so the extent of a partial closure can be fluid. I need to inform parents that we now anticipate that Year 2 will also close on Friday 7th July, meaning that the classes impacted are as follows:

The interruptions have been of varying length, and the cause has proved extremely difficult to diagnose. An expensive repair today will, we hope, bring these problems to an end. We apologise for any changes to the menu that were enforced at the last minute, as electric cookers elsewhere in school have been pressed into service.
