Road Safety Concerns While we are grateful for the efforts of families who are encouraging sustainable journeys to school, including those who 'park and stride', there have been reports in the last two weeks of incidents of dangerous, noisy or silly behaviour from older children who are walking unaccompanied to and from school in large groups. Our

teachers have addressed this matter with their classes and have emphasised the importance of key road safety messages. Because of these concerns, we are asking parents to remind children not to walk in groups larger than three or four children; they should also avoid walking in the road instead of the pavement, and should exercise great care when crossing the road. This will help ensure their safety and minimise risk. We greatly appreciate your co-operation in reinforcing these safety messages.

School Games Cross Country Congratulations to the 32 runners from our school who took part in the cross country races at Wharfe Meadows last week. Well supported by Mrs Sutton, Mrs Marston and some kind parent volunteers, our children competed in a competitive but sporting manner, behaving superbly. Well done everyone!
